CRASH TEST

The latest Helmet collection by Meccaniche Veloci puts the protective gear on its wearer's wrist.

The combination of supercars and watches is neither new nor unique, but few have attempted to do it with two-wheelers. Italian watchmaker Meccaniche Veloci has partnered with motorcycle race helmet maker Suomy to create a line of timepieces featuring dials cut from the latter's helmets. The bold

graphics are designed by Suomy's in-house team and renowned bike racing champions.

Shown here is Due Valvole (\$5,800) from the La Cocca range. The two sub dials are inspired by the two-valve piston engine used in cars. In Singapore, Meccaniche Veloci is available at E'Collezione. www.meccanicheveloci.com

Each sub dial on Due Valvole is powered by independent movements and can be adjusted to display two time zones. This model is limited to 250 pieces.
